Congratulations to our 2009 Ace of Clubs and Mini-McKenney winners, many of whom placed highly in the district as well. Special congratulations to Ying-Chen Y Li who placed tenth ACBL wide in the Mini-McKenney race and sixth ACBL wide in the Ace of Clubs race in the 0-5 masterpoint category. THIS 'N THAT FROM YOUR DISTRICT DIRECTOR

District 3's new year always starts off with the Hilton Rye Town Regional. We had over 2200 tables this year making up for last year because we were snowless. I think this might have been the only week of this winter without any snow. The new event - The Golden Opportunity Pairs - a gold point event for players with 0-750 MP's was a huge success having 91 tables of bridge in play. WOW! Indeed this was a golden opportunity for players with less than 750 master points to win Gold! We are planning to run this event both in Saratoga Springs in June and in Fairfield, NJ in August. At both tournaments the event will be held on Friday. For those of you needing Gold points- be sure not to miss this Golden Opportunity!

Two big decisions that are of interest to all of you will be made at the board meetings in Reno in March. One is the possibility of changing the age for participating in Senior events. Currently, as you know, the age is 55.

Clearly this is very young to be a Senior. So the thought is to raise the age slowly to 60 years. I think I am opposed to this. My feeling is that 92% of our membership is 55 or over. This affords Regionals and Sectionals an opportunity to offer two different game times to almost 100% of our membership. One game is perceived as less competitive and more social. Until the time when we can have two different divisions in some way, this serves the purpose. In areas that are not large enough for both Senior and Open Pairs - Senior games are being dropped. This is fine also, in my opinion.

The other big issue of interest is the "Triple MP Games". that are allowed at the clubs 365 days a year. In the areas where the clubs are doing this it is causing problems with master point races and is hurting the other clubs and sectionals in those units. I am in favor of cutting back on the number of games permitted and also on the num-

ber of points awarded. But then I was never in favor of permitting this .

Hopefully you made plans to play in the Grand National Teams District Event in White Plains on March 27th. and were lucky enough to win and represent District 3 in your flight in the national finals in New Orleans this summer. Read all the results on www.bridge-district3.org, the District 3 web site. Following the GNT's is the Saratoga Springs Regional in June. - plenty of KO's. Compact KO's , Swiss Teams, Golden Opportunity Pairs - a great tournament with restaurants all within walking distance, good playing conditions, wonderful hospitality.
