THIS 'N THAT FROM YOUR DISTRICT DIRECTOR

The ACBL Board concluded its summer meeting in Las Vegas with a number of notable developments:

- Financial condition continues to improve, with expenses down \$689,000 (thanks to no legal settlements and IT savings of \$180,000), Las Vegas attendance slightly above forecast. and San Francisco expected to show good results;
- Membership, however, continues its downward trend, and the temporary membership initiative has been abandoned in favor of a "guest membership" program which will be free but will require full membership to advance beyond the junior master level;
- A new contractor has been retained to handle hotel bookings, effective January '20;
- Also effective 1/20, the minimum age for senior events will be raised to 65, and the Super Senior minimum will be increased to 75;
- Players found guilty of collusive cheating in the past four years will lose any NABC+ titles or second place finishes won in the past, along with their teammates or partners in any prior events, whether or not those prior events were covered in the charges brought;
- In an effort to standardize training and disciplinary procedures, unit recorders and disciplinary committees were eliminated, and duties transferred to district recorders in all cases;
- Progress continues on "Live for Clubs" a program which is designed to replace ACBL score, with the ability for clubs to use outside software if it is compatible.

Despite the continuing membership decline, Las Vegas table count was 13,662, versus 13,500 forecast, notwithstanding significant fee increases (for the first time in ten years, in the case of regional events).

On the District front, our membership is down about 2% in the past year, following the national trend. Our spring regional in Albany experienced lower attendance compared to last year and the resulting financial loss has led the District Board to cancel that regional for next year. On the bright side, our summer regional in Fairfield was a success, in spite of slightly lower table count, and we are hoping for another success in Danbury, where we will inaugurate a full day KO event with gold-point play guaranteed for those who lose in the first round.

The District continues to seek volunteers for the position of webmaster and a potential new position for data analysis, to assist in our marketing efforts and search for new members.
